“Machines, Morality, and (Hu)Mankind: The Future of Artificial Intelligence”

This discussion will begin with an overview of the existing and potential benefits of Artificial Intelligence (AI) technology to society, then focus on the most pressing issues facing policymakers and the tech industry in regard to the existing and potential applications of AI. The panel will ideally be composed of members of the “Partnership on Artificial Intelligence to Benefit People and Society” as well as the co-chair of the White House National Science and Technology Council Subcommittee on Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence. Discussion topics will include, but not be limited to: the societal benefits of AI; the expected effects of automation and AI on the labor market; customer and citizen privacy rights related to machine-learning; the safety and security of AI systems and potential risks of cyber-attack; and the question of “ethics” and responsibility in regard to driverless cars and other AI technologies.
