The event brings together social leaders, policymakers, NGOs, business and academics from a variety of backgrounds.

Papers, round-tables, and panels are invited. We seek proposals based on the multidisciplinary study of the criminal phenomenon, using the humanities and social science to understand the crime, the criminal, the victim, criminality, and society's reaction to crime. Proposals should aim to take rig-orous and critical approaches to criminality and incorporate risk prevention and risk management strategies that consider the dynamics of crime and the ethical and political stakes surrounding it.
